The travel scooter is now confirmed for Frances Marie Sxxxxxxx for the below journey. We wish you a pleasant journey to Iceland and we apologize for the waiting time and the inconvenience this may have caused you.

Please follow the below guidelines, in relation to the battery:

- 1. The battery(ies) must be removed. The wheelchair may then be carried as checked baggage without restriction;
- 2. battery(ies) must be protected from short circuit by insulating the terminals (e.g. by taping over exposed terminals);
- 3. The removed battery(ies) must be protected from damage (e.g.) by placing each battery in a protective pouch. The battery(ies) must be carried in the passenger cabin.
- 4. Removal of the battery(ies) from the device must be performed by following the instructions of the manufacturer or device owner;
- 5. The battery must not exceed 300 Wh, or for a device that is fitted with two batteries required for operation, each battery must not exceed 160 Wh;
- 6. maximum of one spare battery not exceeding 300 Wh or two spares each not exceeding 160 Wh may be carried, in the passenger cabin only.
